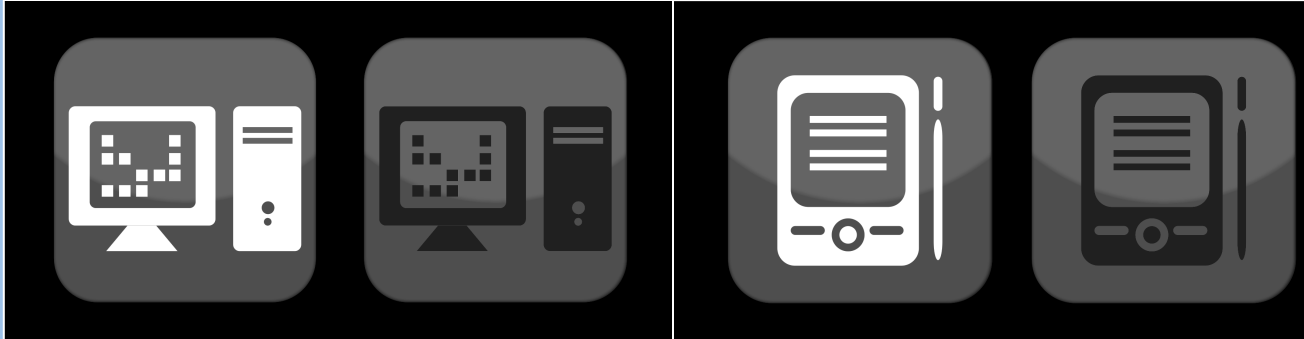

- Currently working in professional and managerial positions in
 - Corporate law
 - Financial and corporate business
 - Education (e.g., policymakers, university and college faculty and academic staff, K-12 principals & superintendents and department of education officials)
- Aged 50 or younger

About the Research Project

The study is conducted under the direction of Richard Alba, Distinguished Professor of Sociology at The City University of New York – Graduate Center.

The aim of the international ELITES Project is to explore today's new upcoming elite of immigrant descent in large cities. The ELITES project highlights the success factors detected in the most successful group. By upcoming elites we mean people working in high-skilled jobs and/or in leadership positions. We want to hear about your pathways to success and about how you influence and reshape today's society. In the European part of this project we compare members of this more visible elite in Sweden, Germany, France and The Netherlands.

The interviews will be anonymized and we ensure that the combination of information cannot be traced to an individual person. Anonymization of data will be done through the use of pseudonyms, and, if necessary, the changing of personal details to protect respondents' privacy.
